# Copenhagen

Denmark is located in northern Europe between the North Sea and the Baltic Sea. It is the southernmost of the three Scandinavian countries and consists of a mainland peninsula, Jutland, and 406 islands. Denmark has a population of 5.3 million people, of whom seven per cent are of foreign origins.

1.7 million people live in the Greater Copenhagen Area. The Øresund Region, consisting of Copenhagen and southern Sweden (Skåne), has a total population of 2.8 million inhabitants.

The capital, Copenhagen, is situated on the island of Sealand and is the largest city in Scandinavia. Copenhagen is a city full of zest and life. A pulsating metropol and historical oasis that offers a wide range of great cultural events, world class sights and attractions, shopping and loads of restaurants, bars, cafés and night clubs.


